Section3. Resignations.

#### a. Discuss and Deliberate HVAC Installation Bids

- Concern was addressed by Cold Zone about the lack of insulation behind the bleachers. We plan to spray foam to seal it from the elements.
- Cold Zone has a 3-week lead time on equipment vs Texas Sheet Metal and Air 6 month lead time.
- EDC has a preference of lead time being more important. Cold Zone's bid is also roughly \$500 cheaper.
- Brandi made a motion to accept Cold Zone's HVAC bid. Second Rolando, Ayes – Garry, James, Rolando, Brandi; Nays – None.
  - EDC has chosen to use Cold Zone and will have him order the units.

#### b. Discuss and Deliberate HVAC Electrical Bids

- Garry made a motion to approve up to \$8,600 for electrical. Brandi second, Ayes – Garry, James, Rolando, Brandi; Nays – None. Motion passed.

#### c. Discuss and Deliberate HVAC Plumbing Bids

#### d. Discuss and Deliberate HVAC Project Total Cost

- 89,700 is current total, we predict final cost would be \$95,000

- Brandi made a motion to make the project cap \$95,000 Garry Second, Ayes Garry, James, Rolando, Brandi; Nays None. Motion Passed.
- e. Discuss and Deliberate Budget Adjustment for Remaining HVAC Project Balance
- Garry made a motion to move up to \$23,000 from the EDC reserve to finish funding the HVAC project. Brandi second, Ayes – Garry, Rolando, James, Brandi; Nays – None. Motion Passed.
- f. Discuss Seeking Alternate Funding for the HVAC/Gym Project
  - James discussed why it would not be in our best interest to ask the City
    of Rice to provide funding for the project. Brandi suggested taking
